## ***EVENT FORMAT***

### **Qualifying**

- Drivers will draw a marble to place into 2 Flights.
- Flight One will set the field for Heats 1 and 2.
- Flight Two will set the field for Heats 3 and 4.
- Qualifying will be in pairs for two laps.
- Cars must time trial in their allocated order. Any Driver that cannot take their drawn position in time trial events may have one lap at the end of their time trial flight with a best possible time of one position less than 50%. The car must be ready for push-off within thirty (30) seconds of the final car completing its lap.
- Any driver that brings a time trial session to a halt e.g. yellow, red light or causes another driver to abort their qualifying lap can only have one recorded lap at the end of that flight. If that driver has recorded one complete lap, then that lap will be counted. Any further laps will be deleted.
- If there is a tie in qualifying, the second-best lap time of those drivers will be used to separate.
- There are no points for qualifying.

### **Non-Qualifiers**

- The top 22 drivers from each flight will be seeded into the Heat races. The remainder of the qualifiers will move to the Non-Qualifiers where the top four (4) transfer to 12th position across the four heat races. (E.g. Position 1 in Non-Qualifiers starts position 12 in Heat 1).
- The remaining finishers will transfer to the back of the C-Feature (format caters for 56 cars to the Mains).
- 12 Laps which may be adjusted to suit the number of cars.

### **Heat Races**

- Drivers will contest one 10 Lap Heat Race.
- The field is set based on qualifying times other than the quickest qualifier in each heat being inverted to start fourth.
- Grid draws will be in a single line, so where a driver is unable to compete in a heat race drivers move forward one position. If there is a restart and a lap has not been completed, the same rule applies.
- The top five in each heat race transfer directly into the A-Feature, with all other cars going to the Last Chance Qualifier (B-Feature) and C-Feature.
- There are no points awarded for Heat races.

### **Australian Racing Products Novelty event**

The Novelty Event takes place of a traditional dash involving the top eight teams.

- The heat race winner and the next A-Feature transfer competitor with the quickest qualifying time will participate in a novelty event.

- Drivers will participate with a crew member and a randomly selected and allocated child from the crowd.
- There is running involved for all participants (driver, crew, child) along with a right rear wheel and wheel wrench...
- The winner of the Novelty event receives a \$1000 Australian Racing Products voucher and starts on pole position for the A-Feature. The remaining drivers will line up as per the finishing order in the novelty event.

### Features

#### **C-Feature** 10 Laps 20 cars

- Drivers finishing tenth to twelfth in the heat race will contest the C-Feature
- The remainder of the C-Feature will be comprised of the finishers in the Non-Qualifiers, lined up in order of finish.
- Top four (4) transfer to B-Feature

#### **Last Chance Qualifier (B-Feature)** 20 Laps 20 cars

- Drivers finishing sixth to ninth in the heat races will contest the Last Chance Qualifier (B- Feature).
- The quickest qualifier not to make the A Main from each flight will start on the front row.
- Grid draw will be in a single line, so where a driver is unable to compete in a Last Chance event drivers move forward one position. If there is a restart and a lap has not been completed, the same rule applies.
- Top four (4) transfer to A-Feature

#### **A-Feature** 35 Laps 24 cars

- The A-Feature Race is 35 laps with starting positions determined by
  - 1 to 8 finishing position in the Novelty event.
  - 9 to 20 based on finishing position in Heats.
  - 21 to 24 based on Last Chance Qualifier results.
- Grid draw will be in a single line, so where a driver is unable to compete in the Feature Race (A-Feature) drivers move forward one position. If there is a restart and a lap has not been completed, the same rule applies.
- Double file restarts to apply during laps 1 to 25 with choose cone.
